

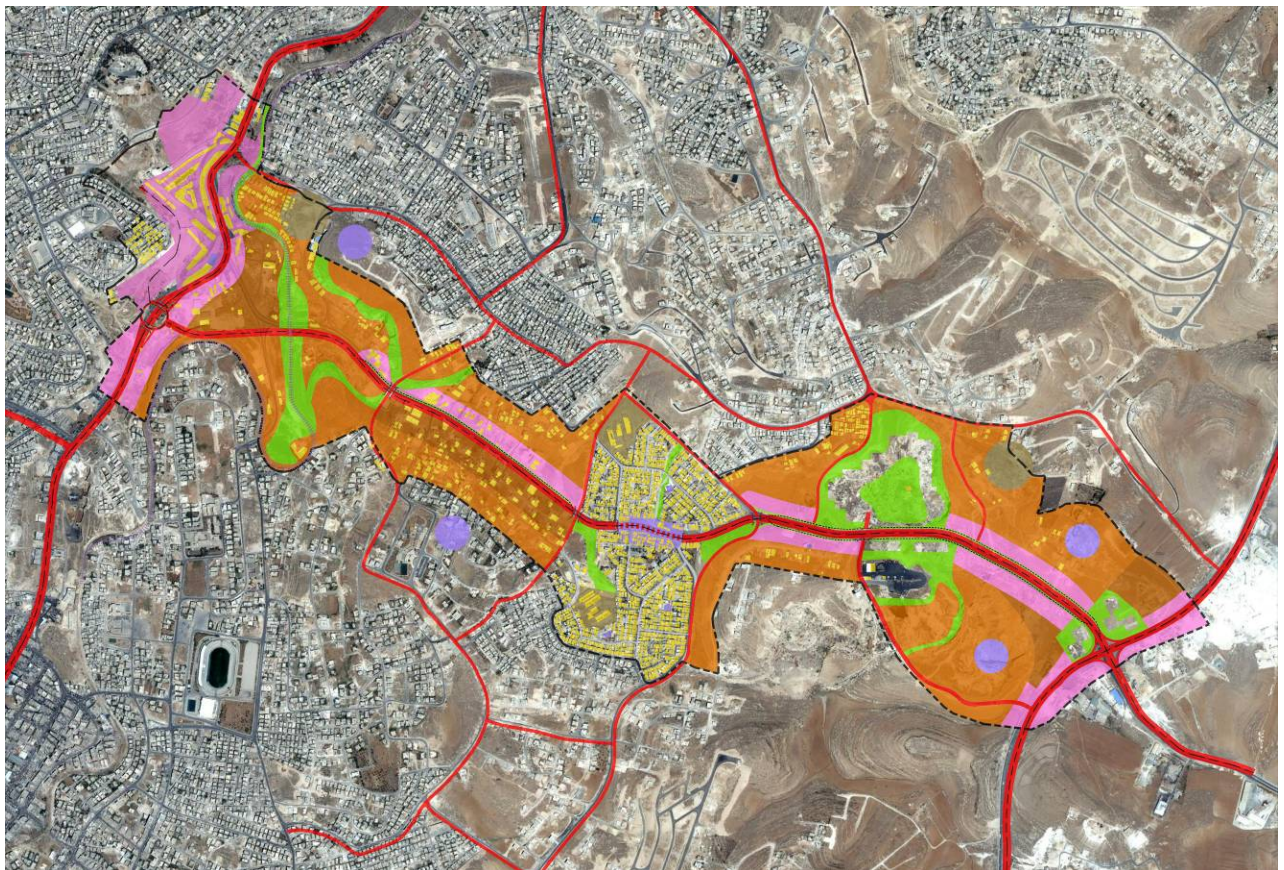

AMMAN EASTERN CORRIDOR AREA DEVELOPMENT PLAN

This project has been assigned by the Greater Amman Municipality (GAM), within the framework of a financial and technical support by the French Development Agency (FDA). It is part of the Amman Plan, an initiative undertaken by the Mayor of Amman under the patronage of H.R.H. King Abdullah that aims to transform Amman into a city that will successfully address the challenges of an urban metropolis of the 21st century.

The Eastern Corridor links the Al Yarmuk ring road to the Al Hizam Al Daeri radial road and extends for more than 6 km. Along this strip the project covers a width of around 500m on the two sides of the highway. The study area covers a total of more than 6 million square meters. The study provides common framework to formulate, prepare and implement densification strategies, policies and measures, supported by appropriate guidelines, rules and design. The project shall also act as a pilot case to codify the principles for the development of public spaces in Amman.
